Syracuse, NY—Reality Check of Onondaga and Cayuga County, programs of Prevention Network, will sponsor a ***free family movie night*** on Wednesday, February 20, 2008, at the Eastwood Palace Theatre. Reality Check has purchased all seats at the theatre for a 6:30pm showing of *The Game Plan*. Admission to the film is free to the first 700 people, with the provision that anyone 13 years old or younger must be accompanied by an adult. No reservations are required. Theatre doors open at 5:30pm that evening. A raffle, prizes and pre-show begin at 5:45pm. Concessions—including popcorn, candy and refreshments—will be available for purchase.
